Basic Services

- Recalls include exams and cleanings once every 9 months
- Bitewing x-rays, 4 every 12 months
- Fluoride treatments, once every 9 months (18 years and under only)
- Complete, general or comprehensive oral exams, full mouth x-rays and panoramic x-rays, once every 3 years
- Basic restorations, fillings and inlays
- Extractions and surgical services

Comprehensive Basic Services

- Endodontic treatment including standard root canal therapy, excluding retreatments
- Periodontal treatment including scaling and/or root planing, 10 time units every 12 months

BASIC ACCIDENTAL DEATH AND DISMEMBERMENT INSURANCE

The basic accidental death and dismemberment (AD&D) plan covers you 24 hours a day, anywhere in the world, for specific accidental losses. If you suffer any of the eligible losses listed in the policy as the result of an accidental injury resulting directly and independently of all over causes and the loss occurs within 365 days of the date of the accident, the benefits indicated in the policy will be paid.

All active students under the age of 70 are insured for a total amount of \$7,500.
