CLASSES AND EXAMS

All academic instruction and evaluation will continue through alternate delivery. There will be no in-person classes or exams before September. Exams may be conducted online, through Nexus, or by other means.

STUDENT IN RESIDENCE

Student in residence have been encourage to leave if able to do so. Those with no alternatives will be accommodated.

If you no longer intend to remain for the Spring Term, you will be able to cancel your contract with no penalties.

If you now need to stay into spring term, but you have not yet applied, you are still eligible to apply and remain in residence.

UW LIBRARY

All in-person library services have been moved to alternate delivery and the physical library facility is now closed. Access to digital resources remains unaffected, and staff are working remotely to delivery most services online.

The Library will be extending material loans until September 15, 2020. Borrowers are encouraged to keep their materials, but books can be returned to the book drop at the south entrance of Centennial Hall by checking in at the security booth.

VOLUNTARY WITHDRAWAL DEADLINE

The voluntary withdrawal date has been extended to Aril 6, to give student additional time to voluntarily withdraw from Winter term courses.

SPRING/SUMMER TERM
