Polling officers facilitate the telephone and in-person voting process for students and aid in the ballot count during the Fall 2021 UWSA By-Election by:

- Arriving on time for their shift at a polling station, or being available to take phone-in ballots for the duration of their shift;
- Explaining the in-person or telephone voting process to students;
- Locating students' names within the voter registry;
- Protecting confidential voter data and acting with integrity;
- Protecting the integrity of the election process;
- Being flexible and available for the duration of the ballot count;
- Engaging students and passers-by and inspiring them to vote;
- Refraining from participation in any campaign for election or referendum.

In order to protect the integrity of UWSA Election and Referenda, applications from the following people will not be considered:

- Current Directors and current and former Executive Directors of the UWSA;
- Current Part-Time or Full-Time Employees of the UWSA;
- Employees of any UWSA partner organization.

**MANDATORY TRAINING will take place on Friday, October 22 from 11 a.m. – 1:30 p.m. in person (location TBD).**

Polling officers must be able to provide proof of vaccination against COVID-19 in accordance with the University of Winnipeg Vaccination Mandate:
