UWSA is committed to creating a campus and community that is positive and free from discrimination and oppression of any kind.

UWSA requires that attendees be respectful and considerate to all other attendees, participants, volunteers and organizers. People of all genders, abilities, ages, cultures and sexualities should feel welcome to participate. Therefore, any form of discrimination is not acceptable.

Behaviour, physical or verbal, that is demeaning, aggressive, or hostile will not be tolerated, including but not limited to:

Racist, sexist, transphobic, homophobic, ableist, and fat phobic comments or actions of any kind, sexual harassment, verbal or physical violence, theft, or wearing clothing or accessories that appropriate another's culture.

The UWSA reserves the right to hold you accountable for your actions, and to remove any attendee who is creating an unsafe atmosphere. Each situation will be addressed on an individual basis. All concerns brought to UWSA staff and event organizers will be taken seriously. To help us address concerns, please communicate with us:
