POSITION REQUIREMENTS:

To be eligible to run for a UWSA office you must be:

- A current UWSA member (i.e. you must be a student at the University of Winnipeg during the time of nomination or currently hold office as a member of the UWSA executive).
- You must have completed 30 credit hours at the University of Winnipeg; or have attended the University of Winnipeg for at least 4 full University terms over a period of no less than 2 years before beginning their term in office.
- You must not currently be bankrupt and must be 18 years of age or older.

The term of the office for Executive is May 1, 2024, through to April 30, 2025.



DESCRIPTION OF POSITIONS

EXECUTIVES

UWSA Executive Directors are full-time, salaried officers (\$40, 000 per year) of the student union. They are the official legal representatives of University of Winnipeg students. Each executive portfolio covers different aspects of the operations of the association, but all of them are charged with bringing business to, and carrying out the decisions of, the UWSA committees and the Board of Directors.

- President: The President is the Chief Executive Officer and Chief Spokesperson
 of the UWSA. The President sits on the University of Winnipeg Senate and Board
 of Regents, Chairs the Executive Committee, and oversees all Vice-Presidential
 portfolios and all business of the union.
- Vice-President External Affairs: The Vice-President External Affairs (VPEA) coordinates the external activities of the UWSA, building external partnerships sand representing University of Winnipeg students to all levels of government. The VPEA is the primarily liaison between the UWSA and the Canadian Federation of Students, coordinates all campaigns of the union, and chairs the Campaigns and External Relations Committee. The VPEA also serves as a liaison between UWSA and student groups.
- Vice-President Student Affairs: The Vice-President Student Affairs (VPSA)
 advises and represents students who need assistance with academic appeals,
 sexual harassment cases, student housing issues, and other student advocacy.
 The VPSA represents students at the university Senate. The VPSA chairs the
 Student Life Committee.
